Evangelist Sheresha Russell, contributes most of her young spiritual and moral development to what she learned while at Mt. Olive Pentecostal Holiness Church with her grandmother.

As time went on, Evangelist Sheresha Russell left Belhaven to attend college at North Carolina A&T State University in 1998, where she obtained her Bachelors of Arts in Psychology in 2002 and a Masters of Arts in Special Education: Learning Disabilities in 2008. During her college years, she attended Mt. Zion Baptist Church of Greensboro, NC under the leadership of Bishop George Brooks. There, she attended and participated in many of the college ministry events.

In 2003, prior to Evangelist Sheresha Russell giving birth to her one and only daughter, Zaria Christine Russell, she began fellowshipping at the Church of Jesus Christ of Nazareth under the leadership of Pastor Lewis Brown in Greensboro, North Carolina. At the Church of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Evangelist Sheresha Russell served as a watchman, Psalmist, and Prophetess. In 2004 at the Church of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Evangelist Sheresha Russell gave her first sermon titled "Maintaining the Balance" which explored applying spiritual principles as a main focus of daily living.


Essentially, we have to be alert to our surroundings and total dependant on Christ to protect us from life threatening situations.

I Samuel 15:1-22 NIV (The Story of Saul as King)

15 Samuel said to Saul, "I am the one the LORD sent to anoint you king over his people Israel; so listen now to the message from the LORD. ² This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'I will punish the Amalekites for what they did to Israel when they waylaid them as they came up from Egypt. ³ Now go, attack the Amalekites and totally destroy all that belongs to them. Do not spare them; put to death men and women, children and infants, cattle and sheep, camels and donkeys."

⁴ So Saul summoned the men and mustered them at Telaim—two hundred thousand foot soldiers and ten thousand from Judah. ⁵ Saul went to the city of Amalek and set an ambush in the ravine. ⁶ Then he said to the Kenites, "Go away, leave the Amalekites so that I do not destroy you along with them; for you showed kindness to all the Israelites when they came up out of Egypt." So the Kenites moved away from the Amalekites.

⁷ Then Saul attacked the Amalekites all the way from Havilah to Shur, near the eastern border of Egypt. ⁸ He took Agag king of the Amalekites alive, and all his people he totally destroyed with the sword. ⁹ But Saul and the army spared Agag and the best of the sheep and cattle, the fat calves and lambs—everything that was good. These they were unwilling to destroy completely, but everything that was despised and weak they totally destroyed.

¹⁰ Then the word of the LORD came to Samuel: ¹¹ "I regret that I have made Saul king, because he has turned away from me and has not carried out my instructions." Samuel was angry, and he cried out to the LORD all that night.

¹² Early in the morning Samuel got up and went to meet Saul, but he was told, "Saul has gone to Carmel. There he has set up a monument in his own honor and has turned and gone on down to Gilgal."

¹³ When Samuel reached him, Saul said, "The LORD bless you! I have carried out the LORD's instructions."

¹⁴ But Samuel said, "What then is this bleating of sheep in my ears? What is this lowing of cattle that I hear?"

¹⁵ Saul answered, "The soldiers brought them from the Amalekites; they spared the best of the sheep and cattle to sacrifice to the LORD your God, but we totally destroyed the rest."

16 "Enough!" Samuel said to Saul. "Let me tell you what the LORD said to me last night."

"Tell me," Saul replied.

¹⁷ Samuel said, "Although you were once small in your own eyes, did you not become the head of the tribes of Israel? The LORD anointed you king over Israel. ¹⁸ And he sent you on a mission, saying, 'Go and completely destroy those wicked people, the Amalekites; wage war against them until you have wiped them out.' ¹⁹ Why did you not obey the LORD? Why did you pounce on the plunder and do evil in the eyes of the LORD?"

²⁰ "But I did obey the LORD," Saul said. "I went on the mission the LORD assigned me. I completely destroyed the Amalekites and brought back Agag their king. ²¹ The soldiers took sheep and cattle from the plunder, the best of what was devoted to God, in order to sacrifice them to the LORD your God at Gilgal."

²² But Samuel replied:

"Does the LORD delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the LORD?

To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams.

²³ For rebellion is like the sin of divination, and arrogance like the evil of idolatry.

Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, he has rejected you as king."

Obey: to comply with or follow the commands, restrictions, wishes, or instructions of....in other words, my answer to you Lord is yes, yes I will do what you say.

Sacrifice: an offering to God or to devote something of value.

When God orders us to do something, he expects us to say yes and carry out what He has requested of us in its' whole entirety. We serve an all seeing and all knowing God, all powerful in His ways. He knows already when we are going to obey Him and when we are going to disobey Him.

In this story, God gave the people just what they wanted, a King to rule over them, when they already had God.

Who is above the Lord our God? Not any man or deity....no one is above God...

Often we place ourselves in predicaments where we are asking God for the same things over and over again as if He did not hear us the first time until eventually...He gives us exactly what we asked for.

We do not know what is best for us, only God does.

The bible tells us in Psalm 146:3 Do not put your trust in princes, in mortal men, who cannot save. In other words, Do not put your confidence in man because man can help you....

To put your trust in man and not God is telling God that He is not who He is (all POWERFUL).

In the text, Saul took the position as King but in taking the position...he took matters into his own hands, disobeying the instructions of God....

God said destroy ALL....Saul destroyed some but spared others....

When God puts you on assignment people of God, He wants you to complete the task as He instructed, not as you deemed necessary....

I it time to stop interfering with Gods work.

Verse 12 tells us that Saul went to set up a monument in honor of himself.....

God does not want us to glorify ourselves but glorify Him by obeying Him.

To do what God tells you is worth more than anything you can ever offer him.

Let your sacrificial offering be obedience!!!!!

Let your yes, be your yes!

GOD CALLS US MOUNTAIN MOVERS

MARK 11:23 ²³For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

MATTHEW 17:20 ²⁰And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

MATTHEW 21:21²¹Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.

It's time to move some mountain!!!

Within the 3 scriptures of focus, you find that all 3 scriptures contain the same focal points.

Those who believe and not doubt shall be able to speak to mountains, mountains meaning obstacles, and the mountains or obstacles must be removed.

In studying the context of Jesus' response to the people who were in shock or amazement of the results of Jesus speaking and miraculous things occurring, Jesus tells the people, if you have faith.

Faith meaning, faith in Him, believing in Him to be the Son of God, then if we only trusted His Words which came to life....we as Believers could possess the same authority....

So many times people get caught up receiving the words of Man and fail to receive the Word of God...

Often people get caught up speaking things into existence or receiving things that God has not granted them permission to have and find themselves in quite a bit of trouble....

God has given us all Power through Him.

Power being an action word.....speaking being an action word....

In the context of the scripture in Jesus tells us to excerise the Power that He has given us and speak to our mountains or situations and MOVE THEM.

GOD HAS GIVEN US POWER

God has given us all Power, through and by the Holy Spirit to speak **those things** that are not, as **though they** are. (Romans 4:17)

God wants us to activate our Faith in Him to cause a shift in our lives and the lives of those that we encounter.

However, to activate and utilize the Power of Jesus Christ, you have to be in right standings with Him, for the Bible declares in Revelations Chapter 3 that God knows if we are hot or cold and we are warned about being lukewarm being told that if we are lukewarm or in other words straddling the fence...that He will sprew us out of His mouth.....

He will vomit us out....

He will rid Himself of us, having nothing to do with us....

To disobey is to reject God....

To reject God is to lose Power...

Jeremiah Chapter 1 Beginning at Verse 4

4Now the word of the LORD came to me saying,

5"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, God says before you were born, created, or even thought about by your mother and father, I knew you....

God said I knew you because I have you on my mind and what I have on my mind I create.....as I produced light, before I ever produced the Sun....

I produced you in a thought, then I produced you in the spirit and flesh.....

So you may ask, how do you know after God thought of me, He created my spirit and not my flesh first.....and the answer is the same way God sent His Word 1st with his Word containing His spirit then the Bible says His Word became flesh....Gods Word is His thoughts and because He thought of you 1st, that's how you know after you were thought of He put His spirit in you and then created the flesh.....

God goes on to tell Jeremiah that before Jeremiah was born He consecrated him

God say before you were born my child I consecrated you meaning I set you apart a special purpose....I set you apart and have declare the assignment of your life to be divine and sacred....

God says I have appointed you a prophet to the nations."

I have chosen you as a prophet

To understand your assignment as a prophet, you must understand and know your identity in the name that God has given you

Jeremiah began to say I don't know how to speak

How many of you know that whatever you don't know how to do, God will instruct you on how to do the task He has told you to do

Where ever I tell you to go, go...even if it is uncomfortable

Whatever I tell you to speak, speak, even if it turns people against you

Do what thus says the Lord, because I am the only one that you are required to answer to

So God stretched out His hands and touched Jeremiah's mouth saying I have put My words in your Mouth and I have appointed you

There God goes again say, I have equipped you with all that you need.....and all that you need is Me....for I have chosen you to fulfill this assignment

To pluck up and to break down,

To destroy and to overthrow,

To build and to plant."

God says I have chosen you to be my Prophet.

To be my Prophet you have to understand the position that I have placed you in, I have positioned you to speak what thus says the Lord and in order to speak what thus says the Lord you have to know My Word and By knowing My Word you know me and By knowing Me, you Know my voice, so that you may be able to distinguish between that which is Me and that which is not Me.

The Bible says in John chapter 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow Me: Meaning that God's sheep are in fine tune with Him, through unceasing disciplines of Studying, Praying, Fasting, and Consistently building a relationship with Him that it is so personal that if the enemy even dared to interfere, that the Holy spirit would rise up with that boldness that only Jesus can give to speak what thus says the Lord and Stand on that.

Know that you have been consecrated and approved to speak *Abundant Life* and live and *Abundant Life*.

RECONCILED IN CHRIST

2 *Corinthians* 5:17-21

¹⁷Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

If we are in Christ then we are washed, cleansed, and purged of all unrighteousness. We are made new from our sinful ways.

¹⁸All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:

God gave His only begotten Son so that we may have life and *LIFE MORE ABUNDANTLY*. We are heirs to His throne and justified/reconciled by His sacrifice.

¹⁹that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

If God can wash us of our sins and give us new beginning, then we should not hold others accountable for their sins. Our responsibility is not to judge or condemn but lead and guide based on the Word and our lifestyles.

²⁰We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

We saints are representative of God; we are to set the examples for sinners to follow. Be at peace and confident in who God has called us to be. Forgive and make peace with those who you have warfare with.

²¹God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

God made Jesus for us so that we MIGHT become the righteousness of Him. Here God gives us a choice.

Will you submit to Him to be reconciled????

To Be Reconciled in Christ is to Receive Abundant Life!

BE A GOOD SAMARITAN

Luke 10:25-37

²⁵ On one occasion an expert in the law stood up to test Jesus. "Teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise"

The moral of the story is to treat others the way you wish to be treated. God sets the perfect example of how we should treat people, we should treat people with Love. God loves all people, though often God's love is rejected by others, He continues to love them anyway. The mind of Christ and the Heart of Christ is what we should strive to have. When you see another in need, don't walk past them, bless them ...bless them with a smile, bless them with a hug, bless them with a word of encouragement, bless them with an offering of food, clothes, or whatever God instructs you to bless them with. ²⁶ "What is written in the Law?" he replied. "How do you read it?"

²⁷ He answered, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind; and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself."

²⁸ "You have answered correctly," Jesus replied. "Do this and you will live."

²⁹ But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

³⁰ In reply Jesus said: "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead. ³¹ A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. ³² So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. ³³ But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. ³⁴ He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him. ³⁵ The next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper. 'Look after him,' he said, 'and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.'

³⁶ "Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?"

³⁷ The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him."
