

Because it attacked her at a vital point, and the thing had preyed on her mind and she was filled with fear so that she said, "I dare not drink, for if I do I shall choke."

Deliverance to the captives. I asked the father and mother to go out of the room and then I said to the young woman, "You will be free and drink as much as you want when I have done with you if you will only believe. As sure as you are there you will drink as much as you want." *Holy Ghost never comes with Condemnation.

Satan is always endeavoring to bring the saints of God into disrepute, bringing against them railing accusations, but the Holy Ghost never comes with condemnation. He always reveals the BLOOD of JESUS. He always brings us help. The Lord JESUS referred to Him as the Comforter who would come. He is always on hand to help in the seasons of trial and test.

The Holy Ghost is the lifting power of the church of JESUS. And Paul tells us that we "are manifestly declared to be the epistle of JESUS, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the heart." The Holy Ghost begins in the heart, right in the depths of human affections. He brings into the heart the riches of the revelation of JESUS, implanting purity and holiness there, so that, out of its depths, praises may well up continually.

The Holy Ghost will make us epistles of JESUS, ever telling out that JESUS our Lord is our Redeemer and God has never put away that revelation. And because of the perfect ATONEMENT of that slain LAMB, there is salvation, healing and deliverance for all. Some people think that they have only to be cleansed once, but as we walk in the light the BLOOD of JESUS is ever cleansing.

The very life of JESUS has been put within us, and is moving within us-a perfect life.



JESUS Loves Righteousness

It is written of JESUS, "Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness." And in this new life in the Spirit, in this new covenant life, you love the things that are right and pure and holy, and shudder at all things that are wrong. JESUS was able to say, "The prince of this world cometh, and bath nothing in Me."

The moment we are filled with the Spirit of God we are brought into like wonderful condition, and, as we continue to be filled with the Spirit, the enemy cannot have an inch of territory in us.

Do you not believe that you can be so filled with the Spirit that a man who is not living right can be judged and convicted by your presence? As we go on in the life of the Spirit, it will be said of us, "in whose eyes a vile person is contemned" (Psalm 15:4).

JESUS lived there and moved in this realm, and His life was a constant reproof to the wickedness around. But He was the Son of God, you say. *Temptation is not SIN

Temptation is not sin; but the devil is a liar and tries to take away our peace. You must live in the Word of God. There is now no condemnation. Who is he that can condemn you? JESUS has died. *Living epistles of the living JESUS

Paul writes: "Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men: forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of JESUS ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the heart."

This is what the Lord does for us when we come to Him; He takes out the heart of stone and gives us a heart of flesh. The Spirit of God will write in both our hearts and minds the law of JESUS. He cleanses us from all iniquity, takes away the old order and brings in the new, and He gives us His blessed Holy Spirit who causes us to walk in a way that is pleasing to Him.

The old life is brought to the CROSS of Calvary. Our old nature is crucified there and we are brought into the position that Paul speaks of when he says, "I am crucified with JESUS; nevertheless I live; yet not I, but JESUS liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me."

Beloved, God would have us see that no man is perfected on any line only as JESUS the living Word abides

in him.

In this new life we must have the Word of God dwelling richly in us. This Word is living and powerful and effective. It is the sword of the Spirit that will prove an effective weapon in the hands of the Spirit-filled warrior. By it we get complete victory over all the power of the enemy. But we need the power of the Spirit within to enable us to wield the sword of the Spirit effectively.

When JESUS dwells in us, our life will be like that life which is described of Him in the Gospels, a life of constant communion with the Father. Ours will be a life of dependence on the Spirit of God, for we do not know how to pray as we ought. It is only as the Spirit prays through us that things will be accomplished for God.

But as we yield ourselves wholly to God and ask for the Spirit, He will graciously give the Spirit so that we can pray in the Holy Ghost. And as we pray in the Holy Ghost we shall see signs and wonders wrought in the name of the holy child JESUS. We can have a ministry of the miraculous even as the early apostles had, if we give ourselves to prayer, for in response to prayer God will send the Pentecostal power as at the beginning.

Nothing is so sweet as to have our hearts yearning with compassion, moved with compassion for the poor and needy. As the Lord fills your heart with love and compassion, you will find the inward cry from the depths of your need is met by the depth of God's love. When God gets into the depths of our hearts He purifies every intention and He fills us with His own joy.

When Moses received the tables of stone and he returned to the people, God made his face to shine. There was a glory in the giving of the law. But there is a more wonderful glory in the giving of the Spirit. Much more wonderful than the shine on Moses' face is the moving of the Spirit to write His commandments on our hearts, the deep movings of the God of eternity as He writes His law of love and compassion into our inner beings. O beloved, let us let the Holy Spirit have His way in our lives to unfold to us the grandeur of JESUS's glory.

The Lord will bring us into a life of humility where we have no confidence in ourselves, but our whole trust rests upon the authority of the mighty God who has promised to be with us at all times. He has made us able ministers of the New Testament, ministers of the Spirit that giveth life. Rivers of living water will flow from us as our confidence rests in Him. As we constantly partake of the living JESUS within, He will give us a message direct from heaven, hot, burning, living.

Just as the old prophets said, "Thus saith the Lord," speaking as the Spirit gave them utterance, so we shall go forth in the power of the Holy Spirit, our whole minds illuminated by the blessed Holy Spirit. He will elevate our minds until we have heavenly minds. We will be able to bring the vision of heavenly things to the people until they will want more of God and more of the Spirit, till they long to be filled with Spirit that they may be fruitful on every line.

I have found that the Baptism in the Holy Ghost infuses into us an intensity of zeal. You will remember it is written of Him, "The zeal of Thine house hath eaten Me up," and we too, like our Lord, will be eaten up of holy zeal. He will fill us with a passion for the good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

The Spirit of God will bring us to the place called Calvary, to the place where we are dead unto sin; but alive unto God, and filled with the resurrection life and power of the living JESUS. Oh, beloved, we must live in the Spirit. We must grow into the likeness of our Master. We must be continually changed from glory to glory as we behold His face, until we are changed into the same image by the Spirit of God.

Have you failed God? He has mercy for you. Out of the depth of your sins and failures you can cry to God for all unrighteousness to be cast out and for His righteousness to be revealed within. JESUS was made sin for you and took your sin, that you might become the righteousness of God in Him, that you might receive

His righteousness. But it means a constant going to the CROSS of Calvary for the bringing to death of the old natural order, that you may come into the supernatural plan of God which He has for you.

God wants each one of us to be indeed an epistle of JESUS, an epistle that recommends JESUS to men. We can only be this as the Spirit of God writes into our hearts and minds the Word. He will make the Word of God life within. Now out of the abundance of a heart steeped in the Word of God there will come forth that which will bring blessing to all those with whom you come in contact. Let your heart cry go up to Him, "O God, lead me step by step in this divine life, for JESUS' sake. Amen."

We must recognize there is only one body. The Scriptures are very definite in saying that all that are JESUS's at His coming will be changed. It doesn't seem to be that we can be all JESUS's without something is done, and God will sweep away so many things which are spoiling things. We must get to perfect love, and we will see that God can make even those in Caesar's household our souls, glory to God!

TONGUES AND INTERPRETATION: "It is the Spirit that joins us and makes us one. It is the health of the Spirit that goes through the body that quickens the body and makes it appear as one."

Oh, the body appearing as one body! The same joy, the same peace, the same hope! No division, all one in

JESUS! What a body! Who can make a body like that? Seems to me that this body is made deep in the CROSS. Hundreds of people are carrying a CROSS on watch guard, or around their necks. I could never carry a CROSS, He has carried the CROSS, He has borne the shame. I find right there in that atoning BLOOD there is cleansing and purifying, and taking away every dross, and everything that will mar the vessel, and He is making a vessel unto honor fit for the Master's use, joined up in that body, one body.

Let us be careful that we do not in any way defile the body because God is chastening the body and fitly framing it and bringing it together. The body of JESUS will rise. You ask, "How will it rise?" It will rise in millions, and billions, and trillions, more than any man can number. It will be a perfect body.

Oh, there is one body! Ah, it is a lovely body. I look at you, I see you. I look in your faces and I know there is a closer association than one can tell or speak about. Oh, brother, there is something deeper down in the spirit of the regenerated person when the dross of life and the flesh falls off.

Oh, there will be a similitude, a likeness, a perfection of holiness, of love! Oh God, take away the rudiments, the weaknesses, all the depravities.

"Now ye are the body of JESUS, and members in particular" (1 Corinthians 12:27).

I like the word, particular, meaning to say there is just the right place for us. God sees us in that place. He is making us fit in that place so that for all time we shall have a wonderful place in that body. Ah, it is so lovely!

Oh, these exhaustless things! Brothers, sisters, it isn't the message, it is the heart. It isn't the heart, it is the JESUS. It isn't the JESUS, it is the God. It isn't the God, it is the whole Body. Deeper and more precious than we have any conception of!


*Bear the Image of the Lord

***Our living hope**

Preached at Bowland Street Mission, March 1917.

"Being begotten again unto a living hope, by the resurrection of JESUS from the dead." [1Pe 1.3]

In 1 Corinthians 15, we read of the glorious fact of JESUS the first-fruits. A farmer goes over his land eagerly scanning the first ears of corn that show themselves above the soil because he knows, as the first beginnings, so may the harvest be. And just in the measure as JESUS is risen from the dead, so are we. As he is, so are we in this world. [1Jn 4.17] JESUS is now getting the church ready for translation. Here, we read in Peter, "We are begotten again into a living hope by the resurrection of JESUS from the dead." [1Pe 1.3] Oh, to be changed—a living fact in the body. Just as in the flesh JESUS triumphed by the Spirit. Oh, to be like him! What a living hope it is!

Paul and Peter were very little together, but both were inspired to bring before the vision of the church this wonderful truth of the living being changed. If JESUS rose not, our faith is vain, we are yet in our sins, [1Co 15.17] it has no foundation. But JESUS has risen and become the first-fruits, [1Co 15.20] and we have now the glorious hope that we shall be so changed. We who were not a people are now the people of God. [1Pe 2.10] Born out of due time, [1Co 15.8] out of the mire, [Ps 69.14] to be among princes.

Beloved, God wants us to see the preciousness of it. It will drive away the dullness of life; it is here set above all other things. JESUS gave all for this treasure. He purchased the field because of the pearl, the pearl of great price [Mt 13.44-46] —the substratum of humanity. JESUS purchased it, and we are the pearl of great price for all time. Our inheritance is in heaven, [1Pe 1.4] and in 1 Thessalonians 4.18, we are told to comfort one another with these words. [1Th 4.18]

What can you have better in the world than the hope that in a little while the change will come? It seems such a short time since I was a boy; in a little while I shall be changed by his grace and be more than a conqueror [Ro 8.37] in an inheritance incorruptible, undefiled, that fadeth not away. [1Pe 1.4] The inheritance is in you, something that is done for you, accomplished by God for you; a work of God wrought out for us by himself, an inheritance incorruptible. When my daughter was in Africa she often wrote of things "corroding." We have a corruptible nature, but, as the natural decays, the spiritual man is at work. As the corruptible is doing its work we are changing.

When will it be seen? When JESUS comes. Most beautiful of all, we shall be like him. What is the process?

Grace: what can work it out: Love: Love: Love: it cannot be rendered in numan phrases. God so loved that he gave JESUS. [Jn 3.16]

There is something very wonderful about being undefiled, there in the presence of my king to be undefiled, never to change, only to be more beautiful. Unless we know something about grace and the omnipotence of his love, we should never be able to grasp it. Love, fathomless as the sea. Grace flowing for you and for me.

He has prepared a place for us, [Jn 14.3] a place which will fit in beautifully, with no fear of anyone else taking it; reserved. When I went to a certain meeting I had a seat reserved and numbered. I could walk in any time. What is there in the reserving? Having a place where we can see him; the very seat we would have chosen. He knows just what we want! There will be no brokenness or jar or wish to have come sooner. He has made us for the place. The beginning of all joys. He loved me so; no jar throughout all eternity. Will you be there? Is it possible for us to miss it? We are kept by the power of God, through faith, unto a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. [1Pe 1.5]

What is there peculiar about it? The fullness of perfection, the ideal of love—the beatitudes worked in. The poor in spirit, the mourners, the meek, the hungry and thirsty, the merciful, the pure [Mt 5.3-8] —all ready to be revealed at the appearing of JESUS. [1Pe 1.7] You could not remain there but for the purifying, the perfecting, the establishing; working out his perfect will when ready! Refined enough, you will go. But there is something to be done yet to establish you, to make you purer.

A great price has been paid. The trial of your faith is more precious than gold that perishes. [1Pe 1.7] Men are losing their heads for gold. And we must give all, yield all, as our Great Refiner puts us again and again in the melting pot; what for? To lose the chaff, that the pure gold of his presence is so clearly seen and His glorious image reflected. From glory to glory even by the Spirit of the Lord. [2Co 3.18] We must be steadfast, immovable, until all his purposes are wrought out.

Praising God on this line in a meeting is a different thing to the time when you are faced with a hard career: there must be no perishing though we are tried by fire. [1Pe 1.7] What is going to appear at the appearing of JESUS? Faith! Faith! The establishing of your heart by the grace of the Spirit, not to crush, but to refine; not to destroy, but to enlarge you. Oh, beloved, to make you know the enemy as a defeated foe, and JESUS not only conquering but displaying the spoils of conquest. The pure in heart shall see God. [Mt 5.8] If thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. [Mt 6.22]

What is it? Loyalty to the word by the power of the BLOOD. You know your inheritance within you is more powerful than all that is without. How many have gone to the stake and through fiery persecution? Did they desire it? Faith tried by fire had power to stand all ridicule, all slander. The faith of the Son of God who, for the joy that was set before him, endured the CROSS. [He 12.2] Oh, the joy bf pleasing him. No trial, no darkness; nothing too hard for me. If only I may see the image of my Lord in it again and again. He removes the skimmings until in the melting pot his face is seen. When it reflects Him, it is pure. Who is looking into our hearts? Who is the refiner? My Lord. He will only remove that which will hinder. Oh, I know the love of God is working out in my heart a great purpose of reality.

I remember going to the Crystal Palace when General [William] Booth had a review of representatives of the Salvation Army from all nations. It was a grand sight as company after company with all their peculiar characteristics passed a certain place where he could view them. It was a wonderful scene. We are going to be presented to him. The trials are getting us ready for the procession and the presentation. We are to be a joy to look at, to be to his praise and glory. [Ep 1.14] No one will be there but the tried by fire. Is it worth it? Yes, a thousand times. Oh, the ecstasy of exalted pleasure. A God thus reveals himself to our hearts.

Verse 22 speaks of unfeigned faith and unfeigned love. [1Pe 1.22] What it means to have unfeigned faith! When ill-used, put to shame, or whatever the process, it never alters, only to be more refined, more like unto him. Unfeigned love full of appreciation for those who do not see eye to eye with you. "Father, forgive them." [Lk 23.34] Remember Stephen: "Lay not this sin to their charge." [Ac 7.60] Unfeigned love is the greatest thing God can bestow on my heart

greatest tilling God call deston oil ling heart.

Verse 23 shows we are saved by a power incorruptible [1Pe 1.23] —a process always refining, a grace always enlarging, a glory always increasing, thus we are made neither barren nor unfruitful, in the knowledge of our Lord JESUS. [2Pe 1.8] The spirits of just men made perfect [He 12.23] are garnered in the treasury of the Most High. Purified as sons. To go out no more. To be as he is—holy, blameless. Through all eternity to gaze upon him with pure, unfeigned love. God glorified in the midst, as the whole company of heaven cry out: "Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty." [Rv 4.8] Verse 35: And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you. [1Pe 1.35]

How can we be sad, or hang our heads or be distressed? Oh, if we only knew how rich we are! Blessed be the name of the Lord.



*He is a living JESUS

Our JESUS is risen. He is a living JESUS who indwells us. We must not have this truth merely as a theory, JESUS must be risen in us by the power of the Spirit. The power that raised Him from the dead must animate us, and as this glorious resurrection power surges through your being, you will be freed from all your weaknesses and you will become strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. There is a resurrection power that God wants you to have and to have it today. Why not? Receive your portion here and now.

Our JESUS is risen. His salvation was not a thing done in a corner. Truly He was a man of glory who went to Calvary for us, in order that He might free us from all that would mar and hinder, that He might transform us by His grace, and bring us out from under the power of Satan into the glorious power of God. One touch of our risen JESUS will raise the dead. Hallelujah!

Oh, this wonderful JESUS of ours! He comes and indwells us. He comes to abide. He it is who baptizes us with the Holy Ghost, and makes everything different. We are to be a kind of first fruits unto God and are to be like JESUS who is the first fruit, walking in His footsteps, living in His power. What a salvation this is, having this risen JESUS in us. I feel that everything else must go to nothingness, helplessness and ruin. Every thought of advantage for ourselves must be on the decrease in order that JESUS may increase, that we may live in another state, where all things are under the power of the Spirit.

Dare you take your inheritance from God? Dare you believe God? Dare you

stand on the record of His Word? What is the record? If thou shalt believe thou shalt see the glory of God. You will be sifted as wheat. You will be tried as though some strange thing tried you. You will be put in places where you will have to put your whole trust in God.

There is no such thing as anyone being tried beyond what God will allow. There is no temptation that will come, but God will be with you right in the temptation to deliver you, and when you have been tried, He will bring you forth as gold. Every trial is to bring you to a greater position in God. The trial that tries your faith will take you on to the place where you will know that the faith of God will be forthcoming in the next test. No man is able to win any victory save through the power of the risen JESUS within him. You will never be able to say, "I did this or that." You will desire to give God the glory for everything.

If you are sure of your ground, if you are counting on the presence of the living JESUS within, you can laugh when you see things getting worse. God would have you settled and grounded in JESUS, and it is only as you are filled with the Holy Ghost that you become steadfast and unmovable in Him.

The Lord JESUS said, "I have a baptism to be baptized with; and how am I straitened till it be accomplished." He was assuredly straitened in the way, at Gethsemane, at the judgment hall, and, after that, at the CROSS, where He, through the eternal Spirit, offered Himself without spot to God.

God will take us right on in like manner, and the Holy Spirit will lead every step of the way. God led Him right through to the empty tomb, to the ascension glory, to a place on the throne; and the Son of God will never be satisfied until He has us with Himself, sharing His glory and sharing His throne.

At the death of Lazarus, when it seemed that Mary and Martha and all around them had lost faith, JESUS turned to the Father and said, "Father, I thank Thee that Thou hast heard Me. And I knew that Thou hearest Me always." Before that supreme faith that counted on God, that counted on His anointing, death had to give up Lazarus.

*Power of the name, The

The Pentecostal Evangel, 20 January 1923.

Preached at the Springfield Assembly, Springfield, Missouri.

All things are possible [Mk 14.36] through the name of JESUS. [Mk 14.36] God hath highly exalted him, and given him the name which is above every name, that at the name of JESUS every knee should bow. [Pp 2.9-10] There is power to overcome everything in the world through the name of JESUS. I am looking forward to a wonderful union through the name of JESUS. There is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. [Ac 4.12]

I want to instill into you a sense of the power, the virtue, and the glory of that name. Six people went into the house of a sick man to pray for him. He was an Episcopalian vicar, and lay in his bed utterly helpless, without even strength to

help himself. He had read a little tract about healing, and had heard about people praying for the sick, and sent for these friends, who, he thought, could pray the prayer of faith. He was anointed according to James 5.14, but because he had no immediate manifestation of healing, he wept bitterly. The six people walked out of the room, somewhat crestfallen to see the man lying there in an unchanged condition.

When they were outside, one of the six said, "There is one thing we might have done. I wish you would all go back with me and try it." They went back and all got together in a group. This brother said, "Let us whisper the name of JESUS." At first when they whispered this worthy name nothing seemed to happen. But as they continued to whisper, "JESUS! JESUS! JESUS!" the power began to fall.

As they saw that God was beginning to work, their faith and joy increased, and they whispered the name louder and louder. As they did so the man arose from his bed and dressed himself. The secret was just this: Those six people had gotten their eyes off the sick man, and they were just taken up with the Lord JESUS himself, and their faith grasped the power that there is in his name. Oh, if people would only appreciate the power that there is in this name, there is no telling what would happen.

I know that through his name, and through the power of his name, we have access to God. The very face of JESUS fills the whole place with glory. All over the world there are people magnifying that name, and oh, what a joy it is for me to utter it.

Peter and John were helpless, were illiterate; they had no college education. They had been with JESUS. [Ac 4.13] To them had come a wonderful revelation of the power of the name of JESUS. They had handed out the bread and fish after JESUS had multiplied them. [Jn 6.5-13] They had sat at the table with him and John had often gazed into his face. Peter had often to be rebuked, but JESUS manifested his love to Peter through it all.

Yea, he loved Peter, the wayward one. Oh, he's a wonderful lover! I have been wayward, I have been stubborn, I had an unmanageable temper at one time, but how patient he has been. I am here to tell you that there is power in JESUS and in his wondrous name to transform anyone, to heal anyone.

If you will see him as God's LAMB, as God's beloved Son who had laid upon him the iniquity of us all. Its 53.61 if only you will see that IESUS paid the

whole price for our redemption that we might be free, you can enter into your purchased inheritance of salvation, of life and of power.

Poor Peter, and poor John! They had no money! [Ac 3.6] But they had faith, they had the power of the Holy Ghost, they had God. You can have God even though you have nothing else. Even though you have lost your character you can have God. I have seen the worst men saved by the power of God.

I was one day preaching about the name of JESUS and there was a man leaning against a lamppost, listening. It took a lamppost to enable him to keep on his feet. We had finished our open-air meeting, and the man was still leaning against the post. I asked him, "Are you sick?" He showed me his hand and I saw beneath his coat: He had a silver-handled dagger. He told me that he was on his way to kill his unfaithful wife, but that he had heard me speaking about the power of the name of JESUS and could not get away. He said that he felt just helpless. I said, "Get you down." And there on the square, with people passing up and down, he got saved.

I took him to my home and put on him a new suit. I saw that there was something in that man that God could use. He said to me the next morning, "God has revealed JESUS to me; I see that all has been laid upon JESUS." I lent him some money, and he soon got together a wonderful little home. His faithless wife was living with another man, but he invited her back to the home that he had prepared for her. She came; and, where enmity and hatred had been before, the whole situation was transformed by love. God made that man a minister wherever he went. There is power in the name of JESUS everywhere. God can save to the uttermost. [He 7.25]

There comes before me a meeting we had in Stockholm that I shall ever bear in mind. There was a home for incurables there and one of the inmates was brought to the meeting. He had palsy and was shaking all over. He stood up before 3,000 people and came to the platform, supported by two others. The power of God fell on him as I anointed him in the name of JESUS. The moment I touched him he dropped his crutch and began to walk in the name of JESUS. He walked down the steps and round that great building in view of all the people. There is nothing that our God cannot do. He will do everything if you will dare to believe.

Someone said to me, "Will you go to this Home for Incurables?" They took me there on my rest day. They brought out the sick people into a great corridor and in one hour the Lord set about 20 of them free.

The name of JESUS is so marvelous. Peter and John had no conception of all that was in that name; neither had the man, lame from his mother's womb, who was laid daily at the gate; [Ac 3.2] but they had faith to say, "In the name of JESUS of Nazareth, rise up and walk." [Ac 3.6] And as Peter took him by the right hand, and lifted him up, immediately his feet and anklebones received strength, and he went into the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God. [Ac 3.7-9] How can it be done? Through his name, through faith in his name, through faith which is by him. [Ac 3.16]



*Power to bind and loose, The

Preached at 70 Victor Road, Bradford, England.

Bible Reading, Matthew 16

The Pharisees and Sadducees had been tempting JESUS to show them a sign from heaven. He showed them that they could discern the signs that appeared on the face of the sky, and yet they could not discern the signs of the times. He would give them no sign to satisfy their unbelieving curiosity, remarking that a wicked and adulterous generation sought after a sign and that no sign should be given to them but the sign of the prophet Jonah. A wicked and adulterous generation stumbles over the story of Jonah, but faith can see in that story a wonderful picture of the death, burial and resurrection of our Lord JESUS.

After JESUS had departed from the Pharisees, and had come to the other side of the lake, He said to His disciples, "Take heed, and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees." The disciples began to reason among themselves, and all they could think of was that they had taken no bread. What were they to do? Then JESUS uttered these words, "O ye of little faith!" He had been so long with them, and yet they were still a great disappointment to Him because of their lack of comprehension and of faith. They could not grasp the profound spiritual truth He was bringing to them and could only think about having brought no bread. "O ve of little faith! Do ve not vet understand, neither

remember the five loaves of the five thousand, and how many baskets ye took up? Neither the seven loaves of the four thousand, and how many baskets ye took up?"

Do you keep in memory how God has been gracious in the past? God has done wonderful things for all of us. If we keep these things in memory we shall become strong in faith. We should be able to defy Satan in everything. Remember all the way the Lord has led. When Joshua passed over Jordan on dry land he told the people to pick up twelve stones and pitch them in Gilgal, and these were to keep the children of Israel in constant memory that they came over Jordan on dry land. How many times had JESUS shown to His disciples the mightiness of His power, and yet they failed in faith right here.

At one time JESUS said to Peter, "What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?" Peter said, "Of strangers." Then JESUS said, "Then are the children free. Nevertheless, lest we should offend them. go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money; that take, and give unto them, for me and thee."

Peter had been at the fishing business all his life but he never had caught a fish with any silver in its mouth. But the Master does not want us to reason things out —for carnal reasoning will always land us in a bog of unbelief—but just to obey. "This is a hard job," Peter must have said, as he put the bait on his hook, "but since You told me to do it, I'll try," and he cast his line into the sea. There were millions of fish in the sea, but every fish had to stand aside and leave that bait alone, and let that fish with the piece of money in his mouth come up and take it.

Do you not see that the words of the Master are the instruction of faith? It is impossible for anything to miss that JESUS says. All His words are spirit and life. If you will only have faith in Him you will find that every word that God gives is life. You cannot be in close touch with Him, and you cannot receive His Word in simple faith without feeling the effect of it in your body as well as in your spirit and soul.

A woman came to me in Cardiff, Wales, who was filled with ulceration. She had fallen in the streets twice through this trouble. She came to the meeting and it seemed as if the evil power within her purposed to kill her right there, for she fell and the power of the devil was rending her sore. She was helpless, and it

seemed as it she had expired. I cried, "O God, help this woman." Then I rebuked the evil power in the name of JESUS, and instantly the Lord healed her. She rose up and made a great to-do. She felt the power of God in her body and wanted to testify all the time.

After three days she went to another place and began to testify about the Lord's power to heal. She came to me and said, "I want to tell everyone about the Lord's healing power. Have you no tracts on this subject?" I handed her my Bible and said, "Matthew, Mark, Luke and John—they are the best tracts on healing. They are full of incidents about the working and power of JESUS. They will never fail to accomplish the work of God if people will but read and believe them."

That is where men lack. All lack of faith is due to not feeding on God's Word. You need it every day. How can you enter into a life of faith? Feed on the living JESUS of whom this Word is full. As you get taken up with the glorious fact and the wondrous presence of the living JESUS, the faith of God will spring up within you. Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of God.

He gives life, not leaven. God has separated us from the leaven of denominationalism, and we dare not go back to it again. Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees. Beware of the unbelief and worldliness that has gotten into and is corrupting all the denominations. God has made us a separated people, and we must keep separated if we are to retain our power. You cannot go back without being corrupted. If we go back, we will lose our power. If we go on, satisfied with being without the camp, even as He was, we will see more of the power and glory of God in our midst.

JESUS asked His disciples what men were saying about Him. They told Him, "Some say that thou art John the Baptist; some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets." Then He put the question, to see what they thought about it, "But whom say ye that I am?" Peter answered, "Thou art the JESUS, the Son of the living God."

JESUS said to him, "Blessed art thou, Simon Bar-Jona: for flesh and BLOOD hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven." It is so simple. Whom do you say He is? Who is He? Do you say with Peter, "Thou art the JESUS, the Son of the living God"? How can you know this.

He is to be revealed. Flesh and BLOOD does not reveal this. It is an inward revelation. God wants to reveal His Son within us and make us conscious of an inward presence. Then you can cry, "I know He's mine. He is mine! He is

mine!" "Neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal Him." Seek God until you get from Him a mighty revelation of the Son, until that inward revelation moves you on to the place where you are always steadfast, unmovable, and always abounding in the work of the Lord.

There is a wonderful power in this revelation. "Upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth, shall be bound in heaven; and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." Was Peter the rock? No.

A few minutes later he was so full of the devil that JESUS had to say to him, "Get thee behind me, Satan; thou art an offense unto me." This rock was JESUS. He is the Rock and there are many scriptures to confirm this. And to everyone that knows that He is the JESUS He gives the key of faith, the power to bind and the power to loose. Stablish your hearts with this fact. God wants you to have the inward revelation of this truth and of all the power contained in it.



From The Book: The Miracles of Smith Wigglesworth



*#148 "I slipped and fell on Broadway, San Diego, in February, 1921 I discovered afterwards that I had fractured the base of my spine. I had so severely wrenched the hips and pelvic bones that I was filled with great pain from that moment forward. As the broken bone was not discovered and set until about two months after the accident, the constant pain and irritation caused a general inflammation of my nervous system, and the long delay in getting the bone set, made it impossible to heal, so that, my condition steadily grew worse, and I was taken to the hospital and the bone was removed about a month after it had been set.

Though the wound healed rapidly, the nervous inflammation remained, and so for many months longer I was in constant pain and unable to get around without assistance. I was taken to the first service held by Mr. Wigglesworth on the 2nd of October, 1922. At the close of the service all those who were sick and in pain and had come for healing were requested to rise if possible. My husband assisted me to my feet, and as those were prayed for by Mister Wigglesworth in the name of Jesus Christ I was instantly healed. How I was healed I do not know. I only know the Great Physician touched my body and I was made whole, and freed from pain.

"After I got home I showed everyone how I could sit down and rise with my hands above my head; when before it had taken both hands to push up my feeble body, and I had to have straps on my bed to pull myself up by. No more use for them now! I lay down and turned over for the first time since the accident without pain. I shall never cease to praise God for the healing of my body through the precious BLOOD of Jesus and in His name. I walked to the street car alone the next day and attended the next service and have been "on the go" ever since. God dwells in you, but you cannot have this divine power until you live and walk in the Holy Ghost, until the power of the new life is greater than the old life."



*WITHOUT SPOT!

*Without spot! Without spot and blameless!

Do you believe it? Who can do it? THE BLOOD CAN DO IT! The BLOOD, the BLOOD, oh the BLOOD! The BLOOD of the LAMB! The BLOOD of JESUS can do it. Spotless, clean, preserved for God.

Give the devil the biggest chase of his life and say these words, "The BLOOD of JESUS JESUS, God's Son, cleanseth us from all unrighteousness."

If ever you hear a row like that in any christian Science meeting about the BLOOD of JESUS, go and I will tell you they are being converted. If you ever hear, tell of Russellism getting excited over the BLOOD of JESUS, I can tell you God has dealt with them. If ever you hear about this new man in theosophy getting excited about the BLOOD of JESUS, you can tell them from Wigglesworth that there is a. new order in the world. But they have no room for the BLOOD. And yet we see the BLOOD is preparing us for this great day.



Smith Wigglesworth: Preachers with sugar-coated

pills or with slimy tongues!

You be careful when anybody comes to you with a sugar-coated pill or with a slimy tongue. They are always of the devil. The Spirit of the Lord will always deal with truth. These people never deal with truth. They always cover up the truth. "Oh, you know, we are all sons of God. We all belong to God." That is what people said when JESUS was here, and He said, "You are mistaken. You belong to the devil." And if JESUS dared say things like that, I dare to say it also!



*The Spirit of God is crying, "Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money: come ye, buy and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price." The Spirit of God will take of the things of JESUS and show them to you in order that you may have a longing for JESUS in His fullness, and when there is that longing, God will not fail to fill you.

See that crowd of worshipers who have come up to the feast. They are going away utterly unsatisfied, but on the last day, the great day of the feast, JESUS stands up and cries. "If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water."

JESUS knew that they were going away without the living water, and so He directs them to the true source of supply. Are you thirsty today? The living JESUS still invites you to Himself, and I want to testify that He still satisfies the thirsty soul and still fills the hungry with good things.



*Pressing Through

In the second chapter of Mark we have the wonderful story of the healing of the one sick of the palsy who was laid at the feet of the Lord JESUS. JESUS spoke a word, "and immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went forth before them all; insomuch that they were all amazed, and glorified God, saying, We never saw it on this fashion."

JESUS Christ is the same yesterday, and today, and forever, and wants to manifest Himself in our midst in a similar way. It is His purpose that signs and wonders shall be seen in our midst, and men shall go away and declare, "We never saw it on this fashion."

God wants the gifts of healings and the working of miracles to be seen in our midst. In the book of Acts we read, "There came also a multitude out of the cities round about Jerusalem bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits and they were healed everyone." God wants us to move on into a Pentecostal experience where we shall see this happen in every meeting.

I believe that if there is anything that God is dissatisfied with, it is our settling down into a stationary condition. We stop on the threshold, when God in His great plan is inviting us into His treasury. Oh, this treasury of the Most High, the unsearchable riches of JESUS, this divine position which God wants to move us into, so that we are altogether a new creation, the old self-life having passed away, where we are dead unto sin but alive unto God through JESUS our Lord!

There is one thing that hinders, and that is the carnal mind, which is enmity against God. But there is a glorious victory over carnality through the CROSS of JESUS. My Bible tells me that my old man with all his carnality was crucified with JESUS. At the CROSS of JESUS there is victory complete and full over all the old self-life. God wants us to know the resurrection power of the Lord, and to bring us into a place of rest, of faith, of joy and peace and blessing and of fulness of life; the very same Spirit which raised up JESUS from the dead quickening our mortal bodies so that we are full and overflowing with the life of JESUS Himself.

May the Lord give us a new vision of Himself, and such a fulness of His divine life that we will shake off all that remains of the old life. Let us pray that He may bring us fully into all the newness of life. May He reveal to us the greatness of His will concerning us for there is no one who loves us as JESUS, there is no love like His, no compassion like His. He is filled with love and never fails to take those who fully obey Him into the promised land.

O beloved, that is a lovely thing to do, to drop right out of your self-righteous unbelief, right into the arms of JESUS, who will meet every need of yours for spirit, soul, and body. I find some people who have been in a strange place of deadness for years; but press through to our lovely JESUS and He will shake you out of it. He can make perfection out of imperfection by His wondrous loving touch.

I tell you, my sister, my brother, that when JESUS's BLOOD was shed, He paid the full price and met all the world's needs. Truly our Lord JESUS has met the need of the broken hearts and the sorrowful spirits, and also the withered limbs and the broken bodies. God's dear Son paid the debt for all, for He took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses. In all points He was tempted like as we are, in order that He might be able to succor them that are tempted.



*Peter goes on to say, "According as His divine power bath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him that hath called us to glory and virtue." God is calling us to this realm of glory and virtue where, as we feed on His exceeding great and precious promises, we are made partakers of the divine nature.

Faith is the substance of things hoped for right here in this life. It is right here that God would have us partake of His divine nature. It is nothing less than the life of the Lord Himself imparted and flowing into our whole beings, so that our very body is quickened, so that every tissue and every drop of BLOOD and our bones and joints and marrow receive this divine life.

I believe that the Lord wants this divine life to flow right into our natural bodies, this law of the spirit of life in JESUS that makes us free from the law of sin and death. God wants to establish our faith so that we shall lay hold on this divine life, this divine nature of the Son of God, so that our spirit and soul and body will be sanctified wholly and preserved unto the corning of the Lord JESUS.



*Our Lord JESUS has made it unmistakably plain to all His followers for all time that the world is contrary to Him and to His kingdom. He said concerning His disciples, "I have given them thy word; and THE WORLD HATH HATED THEM, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world."

The devil and all his evil hosts are also arrayed against all manifestations of God. The devil is "the prince of this world;" and he is "the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience." All these are opposed to God and His working; but they can never defeat the purposes of God.



*If you have truly received JESUS as your Lord and Savior, it has been because the Father drew you to Him; for He said, "No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him." And we may be sure that God will not go back on what He has begun to do; for our Lord JESUS added to the above, "And I will raise him up at the last day."

Also the apostle Paul says, in Philippians 1:6, "Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of JESUS."



* JESUS Condemns You Not

"There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in JESUS." If JESUS condemns you not, who is he that can condemn you? Do not condemn yourself. If there is anything wrong, confess it out and then come to the BLOOD of

JESUS. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the BLOOD of JESUS His Son cleanseth us from all sin."

A wicked and adulterous generation stumbles over the story of Jonah, but faith can see in that story a wonderful picture of the death, burial and resurrection of our Lord JESUS.

After JESUS had departed from the Pharisees, and had come to the other side of the lake, He said to His disciples, "Take heed, and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees." The disciples began to reason among themselves; and all they could think of was that they had taken no bread. What were they to do?

Then JESUS uttered these words, "O ye of little faith!" He had been so long with them, and yet they were still a great disappointment to Him, because of their lack of comprehension and of faith. They could not grasp the profound spiritual truth He was bringing to them, and could only think about having brought no bread. "O ye of little faith! Do ye not yet understand, neither remember the five loaves of the five thousand, and how many baskets ye took up? Neither the seven loaves of the four thousand, and how many baskets ye took up?"



* Full Redemption In JESUS

Right now the precious BLOOD of the Lord JESUS is efficacious to cleanse your heart and bring this life, this wonderful life of God, within you. The BLOOD will make you every whit whole if you dare believe.

The Bible is full of entreaty for you to come and partake and receive the grace, the power, the strength, the righteousness, and the full redemption of JESUS. He never fails to hear when we believe.



*To Be Like JESUS

The word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit...and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

--Hebrews 4:12

Scripture reading: Philippians 2:1-22

We have yet to see the forcefulness of the Word of God. The Word, the life, the presence, the power is in your body, in the very marrow of your bones, and absolutely everything else must be discharged. Sometimes we do not fully reflect on this wonderful truth: the Word, the life, the JESUS who is the Word divides you from soul affection, from human weakness, from all depravity. The BLOOD of JESUS can cleanse you until your soul is purified and your nature is destroyed by the nature of the living JESUS.

In JESUS, we have encountered divine resurrection touches. In the greatest work God ever did on the face of the earth, JESUS was raised from the dead by the operation of the power of God. As the resurrection of JESUS operates in our hearts, it will dethrone wrong things and will build right things. Callousness will have to change; hardness will have to disappear; all evil thoughts will have to go. In the place of these will be lowliness of mind.

What beautiful cooperation with God in thought and power and holiness! The Master "made Himself of no reputation" (Phil. 2:7). He absolutely left the glory of heaven, with all its wonder. He left it and submitted Himself to humiliation. He went down, down, down into death for one purpose only: that He might destroy the power of death, even the Devil, and deliver those people who all their lifetime have been subject to fear--deliver them from the fear of death and the Devil (Heb. 2:14-15).

How will this wonderful plan come to pass? By transformation, resurrection, thoughts of holiness, intense zeal, desire for all of God, until we live and move in the atmosphere of holiness.

Thought for today: If you will let go, God will take hold and keep you up.



*JESUS, our blessed Lord, was the most meek, the most lovely, and the most beautiful in character. You never find him like this: "Stand aside now. I am a man who has the gifts!" You never find that in JESUS, but he was so moved with compassion that he could raise the widow's son. [Lk 7.11-17] We will not have had compassion except by the inward power of God moving us. Everybody can be humble. It costs nothing except your pride and ugly self to be put out of the way.



*"The BLOOD has never Lost its Power."

As we get in touch with JESUS, wonderful things will take place; and what else? We shall get nearer and nearer to Him.

There is another side to it. "…exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord JESUS, saying, We adjure you by JESUS whom Paul preached and the evil spirit answered and said, JESUS I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?" (Acts 19:13,15). I beseech you in the name of JESUS, especially those of you who are baptized, to awaken up to the fact that you have power if God is with you; but there must be a resemblance between you and JESUS. The evil spirit said, "…JESUS I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?" (Acts 19:15). Paul had the resemblance.

You are not going to get it without having His presence; His presence changes you. You are not going to be able to get the results without the marks of the Lord JESUS. The man must have the divine power within himself; devils will take no notice of any power if they do not see the JESUS. "JESUS I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?" The difference between these men was they had not the marks of JESUS, so the manifestation of the power of JESUS was not seen.

You want power: don't take the wrong way. Don't take it as power because you speak in tongues, and if God has given you revelations along certain lines don't take that for the power; or if you have even laid hands on the sick and they have been healed, don't take that for the power. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me..." (Luke 4:18); that alone is the power. Don't be deceived; there is a place to get where you know the Spirit is upon you, so you will be able to do the works which are wrought by this blessed Spirit of God in you, and the manifestation of His power shall be seen, and people will believe in the Lord.

What will make men believe the divine promises of God? Beloved, let me say to you today, God wants you to be ministering spirits, and it means to be clothed with another power. And this divine power, you know when it is there, and you know when it goes forth. The baptism of JESUS must bring us to have a single eye to the glory of God; everything else is wasted time and wasted energy. Beloved, we can reach it; it is a high mark but we can get to it. You ask how? "What wilt thou have me to do?" That is the plan. It means a perfect surrender to the call of God, and perfect obedience.



* Healing Through the BLOOD of JESUS

There is healing through the BLOOD of JESUS and deliverance for every captive. God never intended His children to live in misery because of some affliction that comes directly from the devil. A perfect ATONEMENT was made at Calvary. I believe that JESUS bore my sins, and I am free from them all. I am justified from all things if I dare believe. He Himself took our infirmities and bare our sicknesses; and if I dare believe, I can be healed.

See this poor, helpless man at the pool. "Wilt thou be made whole?" But there is a difficulty in the way. The man has one eye on the pool and one on JESUS. There are many people getting Cross-eyed this way these days; they have one eye on the doctor and one on JESUS. If you will only look to JESUS and put both your eyes on Him you can be made every whit whole, spirit, soul and body. It is the word of the living God that they that believe should be justified, made free from all things. And whom the Son sets free is free indeed.

You say, "Oh, if I only could believe!" He understands. JESUS knew he had been a long time in that case. He is full of compassion. He knows that kidney trouble, He knows those corns, He knows that neuralgia. There is nothing He does not know. He only wants a chance to show Himself merciful and gracious to you. But He wants to encourage you to believe Him.

If thou canst only believe, thou canst be saved and healed. Dare to believe that JESUS was wounded for your transgressions, was bruised for your iniquities, was chastised that you might have peace, and that by His stripes there is healing for you right here and now. You have failed because you have not believed Him. Cry out to Him even now, "Lord, I believe, help Thou mine unbelief."

We have a God who answers prayer

JESUS meant this man at the pool to be a testimony forever. When he had both eyes on JESUS, He said to him, "Do the impossible thing. Rise, take up thy bed, and walk." JESUS called on the man with the withered hand to do the impossible-to stretch forth his hand. The man did the impossible thing-he stretched out his hand, and it was made every whit whole. And so with this impotent man-he began to rise, and he found the power of God moving within.

He wrapped up his bed and began to walk off. It was the Sabbath day, and there were some of those folks around who think much more of a day than they do of the Lord; and they began to make a fuss. When the power of God is in manifestation, a protest will always come from some hypocrites. JESUS knew all about what the man was going through, and met him again; and this time He said to him, "Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee."

There is a close relationship between sin and sickness. How many know that their sickness is a direct result of sin? I hope that no one will come to be prayed for who is living in sin. But if you will obey God and repent of your sin and quit it, God will meet you, and neither your sickness nor your sin will remain. "The prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him."

Faith is just the open door through which the Lord comes. Do not say, "I was healed by faith." Faith does not save. God saves through that open door. Healing comes the same way. You believe, and the virtue of JESUS comes. Healing is for the glory of God. I am here because God healed me when I was dying; and I have been all round the world preaching this full redemption, doing all I can to

bring glory to the wonderful name of JESUS, through whom I was healed.

"Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon thee." The Lord told us in one place about an evil spirit going out from a man. The house that he left got all swept arid garnished, but it received no new occupant. And that evil spirit, with seven other spirits more wicked than himself, went back to that unoccupied house, and the last stage of the man was worse than the first. The Lord does not heal you to go to a baseball game or to a race meet. He heals you for His glory and that from henceforth your life shall glorify Him. But this man remained stationary. He did not magnify God. He did not seek to be filled with the Spirit. And his last state became worse than the first.

The Lord would so cleanse the motive and desires of our hearts that we will seek but one thing only, and that is, His glory.



*Tongues and interpretation. "The Spirit quickeneth the mortal body and bringeth us into like-mindedness with JESUS till the whole heart and mind are transformed and so made pure that God can bring into us all his revelation, all his life, and all his purity; till everything we move amongst is changed. As he was, so are we in the world, to glorify and magnify the Lord of hosts amongst the heathen."



***Q:** Which is the right way to baptize, in the name of JESUS, or the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost?

A: Always do that which causes no contention and no split. Water baptism in the name of JESUS causes more trouble than anything else, and you should never have trouble in the church, you should be at peace. The Lord said it was to be in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, and when we keep in the right order, as He said, then there is no schism in the body.

When you go on your own line and strike out a new cord, you cause dissension and trouble. This thing has caused more trouble than anything because it has not been satisfied to go there.

It has gone further and said that JESUS is the Father, JESUS is the Son, and JESUS is the Holy Ghost. If you do not keep on the right line, keep in the words where JESUS was, you will be toppled over in awful distress and darkness. Keep on the high line.



* I am Crucified with JESUS

"I am crucified with JESUS: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but JESUS liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me" (Galatians 2:20).

How can JESUS live in you? There is no way for JESUS to live in you only by the manifested Word in you, through you, manifestly declaring every day that you are a living epistle of the Word of God. Beloved, God would have us to see that no man is perfected or equipped on any lines only as the living Word abides in Him.

It is the living JESUS, it is the divine likeness to God, it is the express image of Him, and the Word is the only factor that works out in you and brings forth these glories of identification between you and JESUS. It is the Word dwelling in your hearts, richly by faith.



*Mouthpiece of God

We must now be the mouthpiece of God, not by letter but by the Spirit. And we must be so in the will of God that God rejoices over us with singing. Isn't it lovely? We are going forward a little. Let us turn now to the thirteenth and

fourteenth verses:

And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not steadfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:

But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in JESUS. 2 Corinthians 3:13,14

I have nothing to say about the Jew except this: that I know I am saved by the BLOOD of a Jew. I owe my Bible to the Jews, for the Jews have kept it for us. We have a Savior who was a Jew. The first proclamation of the Gospel was of the Jews. I know that I owe everything to the Jew today, but I see that the Jew will never have the key to unlock the Scriptures till he sees JESUS. The moment he does he will see this truth that JESUS gave to Peter:

And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church...And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 16:18,19

And I will give thee the key of truth, the key to unveil. The key was brought in the moment Peter saw the Lord. The moment they see JESUS, the whole of the Scriptures is opened out to the Jew. That will be a great day when the Jews see the Lord. They will see Him!

But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in JESUS.

But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart.

2 Corinthians 3:14,15

God doesn't say the vail is upon their mind, but upon their heart. And beloved, God can never save a man through his mind. He saves him through his heart. He can never bring all the glories into a man's life by his mind. He must touch the deep things of his heart.



* The Testimony of JESUS

We must testify only as the Spirit gives utterance. We find in Revelation that the testimony of JESUS is the spirit of prophecy.

When your flesh is keeping you down, but your heart is so full it is lifting you up - have you ever been like that? The flesh has been fastening you to the seat but your heart has been bubbling over. At last the heart has had more power and you have risen up.

And then in that heart affection for JESUS in the Spirit of love and in the knowledge of truth, you begin to testify, and when you have done you sit down. Liberty used wrongly goes on when you finished and spoils the meeting. You are not to use your liberty except for the glory of God.

Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the BLOOD of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

*#204 The campaign began in a large hall capable of holding a thousand people. From the first night it was a great success, hundreds were saved, not a night passing by without many standing up in response to the appeals of the Evangelist stretching their hands up to heaven, calling out, "Jesus save me, Jesus deliver me," and then, as they stood up, the Evangelist would pray, asking the Lord to have mercy upon them and save them; then the whole audience would sing, "I do believe, I will believe, that Jesus died for me, that on the CROSS, He shed His BLOOD, for sin to set me free."

Every night he would single out people in the audience, who were in pain and pray for them, and immediately after prayer was offered the suffering one would testify that they were free from pain. If it was a case of stiff limbs, they were made to exercise them by walking up and down, running, stamping their feet, or

waving their arms about in order to test whether the pain had actually gone or not.

"But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed." (Isaiah 53:5)



#8 The Seed of Abraham, Gods people Israel will be purged

"For I will cleanse their BLOOD that I have not cleansed: for the Lord dwells in Zion" (Joel 3:21)



#9 I am cleansed

"But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the BLOOD of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin." (I John 1:7)



#10 Power to overcome the enemy

"And they overcame him by the BLOOD of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they loved not their lives unto the death." (Revelation 12:11)



#11 No longer under the curse of the law

"Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree")." (Galatians 3:13)



#12 Delivered from the enemy

"In Him we have redemption through His BLOOD, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace." (Ephesians 1:7)



#13 No longer a stranger to God's covenant of promise

"...that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the BLOOD of Christ." (Ephesians 2:12-13)



#14 Final Atonement has been made on our behalf

"For the life of a creature is in the BLOOD, and I have given it to you to make atonement for yourselves on the altar; it is the BLOOD that makes atonement for one's life." (Leviticus 17:11)



#15 Translated from the enemy's kingdom into God's

"Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it." (Colossians 2:15)



#16 I have access to God's Grace

"In Him we have redemption through His BLOOD, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace." (Ephesians 1:7)



#17 I have received Conferred righteousness

"For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." (2 Corinthians 5:21)



#18 I have been justified by the BLOOD of Jesus

"being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His BLOOD, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed..." (Romans 3:24-25)



#19 I am able to draw nigh to God

"But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the BLOOD of Christ." (Ephesians 2:13)



#20 Partaker of His Sufferings and sacrifice

"Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My BLOOD, which is shed for you." (Luke 22:20)



#21 My redemption is Eternal

"Knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious BLOOD of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot." (1 Peter 1:18-19)



#22 Jesus declares I am clean by His BLOOD

"...and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own BLOOD and has made us kings[and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen." (Revelation 1:5)



#23 I am free by His BLOOD

"Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage." (Galatians 5:1)



#24 The Death Angel MUST pass over me

"that you shall say, 'It is the Passover sacrifice of the Lord, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt when He struck the Egyptians and delivered our households.'" So the people bowed their heads and worshiped." (Exodus 12:27)



#25 I am free from an evil conscience

"let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water." (Hebrews 10:22)



#26 No longer condemned

"There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit." (Romans 8:1)



#27 Separated from the world by Faith in Christ

"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." (Galatians 2:20)



#28 I can Live in total Victory

"And they overcame him by the BLOOD of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they loved not their lives unto the death." (Revelation 12:11)



#29 I can enter boldly into the holiest of holies

"Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the BLOOD of Jesus, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and having a High Priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water." (Hebrews 10:19-22)



#30 Greater revelation of God is available

"who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high..." (Hebrews 1:3)



How to Live in the Miraculous!

This is a quick explanation of how to live and move in the realm of the miraculous. Seeing divine interventions of God is not something that just spontaneously happens because you have been born-again. There are certain biblical principles and truths that must be evident in your life. This is a very basic list of some of these truths and laws:

1. You must give JESUS Christ your whole heart. You cannot be lackadaisical

in this endeavour. Being lukewarm in your walk with God is repulsive to the Lord. He wants 100% commitment. JESUS gave His all, now it is our turn to give our all. He loved us 100%. Now we must love Him 100%.

My son, give me thine heart, and let thine eyes observe my ways (Proverbs 23:26).

So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew thee out of my mouth (Revelation 3:16).

2. There must be a complete agreement with God's Word. We must be in harmony with the Lord in our attitude, actions, thoughts, and deeds. Whatever the Word of God declares in the New Testament is what we wholeheartedly agree with.

Can two walk together, except they be agreed? (Amos 3:3).

For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him (2 Chronicles 16:9).

3. Obey and do the Word from the heart, from the simplest to the most complicated request or command. No matter what the Word says to do, do it! Here are some simple examples: Lift your hands in praise, in everything give thanks, forgive instantly, gather together with the saints, and give offerings to the Lord, and so on.

I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me (John 5:30).

4. Make JESUS the highest priority of your life. Everything you do, do not do it as unto men, but do it as unto God.

If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth (Colossians 3:1-2).

5. Die to self! The old man says, "My will be done!" The new man says, "God's will be done!"

Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him (Romans 6:8).

6. Repent the minute you get out of God's will — no matter how minor, or small the sin may seem.

(Revelation 3:19).

As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

7. Take one step at a time. God will test you (not to do evil) to see if you will obey him. *Whatever He tells you to do: by His Word, by His Spirit, or within your conscience, do it.* He will never tell you to do something contrary to His nature or His Word!

For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother (Matthew 12:50).

Then went he down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was clean (2 Kings 5:14).
